This device is intended for use only for general wellbeing purposes or to encourage or maintain a healthy

lifestyle, and is not intended to be used for any medical purpose (such as the detection, diagnosis, monitoring,

management or treatment of any medical condition or disease).

Please consult a physician for any medical advice required.

This device is for domestic use only and must not be used outside of the country for safety and legal reasons.

Never open the case as high voltage is generated inside of the main body. Do not disassemble, repair, or modify the main body and accessories.

Failure to do so may cause injury such as electric shock or a fault.

Do not wash the main body and accessories in water.

- or frequent vibrations.
- Do not place the device in a hot place where there is a heater nearby or where it is exposed to direct sunlight.
- Do not put the device in a place where dust, salt, sulfur etc. may cause adverse effects.

#### Keep the main body and accessories away from a container of liquid such as a vase or an aquarium.

If liquid enters the device, it may cause a fire or a breakdown.

When you apply the plates to the body, be careful not to bend them too sharply by tightening them excessively.

The plates may be damaged if bent too much.

#### Cautions during use

# **∧** Caution

When you feel any abnormalities in your body, stop using the device immediately. People around you should not touch the person who is using the product.

In the event of a blackout, switch off the device immediately.

Always stop operation before using it on another part of the body or on another person while it is in use.



Do not allow metal objects (bed, chair, precious metal, etc.) to come in contact with the body and plates during use.

Do not use for more than 60 minutes at a time.

#### **Cautions after use**



Please turn off the power switch on the front of the unit after use.

Before moving the unit, remove the AC adapter and the plates from the unit. In addition, hold the unit with both hands to prevent if from falling down.

If you accidentally drop the unit, be sure to contact the dealer where you purchased it for inspection. Otherwise, even if the appearance and operation are normal, there may be malfunctions and

accidents in the future.

If you apply the plates after starting operation, the plates may be damaged and you may feel an unpleasant electric stimulation similar to static shock.

Stop operating the device firstly in case of removing the plates from applied parts.

When applied part of the plates are wet with sweat or covered with ointment, make sure to wipe it off before use.

When a plate is wet or damp with sweat, dry it completely before use. Never attempt to dry it using a hair dryer or heater as it may result in damage.

If any of the plates are damaged or in a fault condition, discontinue use immediately.

Consult your dealer or our company as it is dangerous to make a repair by yourself or use the device continuously.

#### Do not install or use the product in the following locations.

• Do not put the device on an inclined surface or in an unstable location where it is subjected to shock

Also, while using the product, do not touch people or things around you.

Have at least one hour between the end of the last use and the start of the next use.

# 3. Name and function of each part of the main body

# 1. How to connect plates

Insert the plug while holding the main body so that it does not move.



# 2. How to wrap with spiral tubes

Wrap the plate cables with the provided spiral tubes in spots.



# 3. How to fit the cover with velcro loop

Fit a provided cover with velcro loop. Open the hook and loop closure on one side of the cover with velcro loop, and insert the plate in it.

Then close the hook and loop closure.

# 4. How to fit the velcro with square buckle

Pass the velcro through the velcro loop of the cover with velcro loop as shown in the figure on the right. Pay attention to the orientation of the velcro and cover.



 $(\mathbf{2})$ Turn it over so that the surface of the cover is facing you.



(3) Secure the velcro through the square buckle with hook and loop closure.

# 5. How to connect AC adapter

Connect the DC plug of the AC adapter into the DC plug socket on the back of the main body.



#### direct contact with the DC plug may adversely affect the inside of the equipment due to static electricity, etc.

pull the DC plug cover as shown by the arrow to release it.

%The basics should not be removed as shown in the left sentence.

#### Insert the AC plug into the outlet

- ① Put the equipment on a fixed, stable and flat place avoiding direct sunlight.
- ② Hold the AC adapter plug and insert it all the way into the outlet (household 100-240V AC) straight and firmly to avoid loosening or disconnecting.

# 6. Method of use

#### Typical use case

Period	Single use time	
Day 1 - Day 3	5 to 10 min	lf you feel temporar

① The above table is an example of standard use.

Please adjust the duration of use and the number of times per day according to your physical condition.

② Allow at least one hour after each use before the next use.

- ③ When using the product for the first time, use it for a short time (5 to 10 minutes) and gradually acclimate your body to it through repeated use.
- ④ If you feel temporary weakness, shorten the duration of each use or reduce the number of times you use it in a day.

(5) Depending on the age, physical strength, and weight of the user, such as children and the frail, adjust the duration of use appropriately, such as 20 minutes or less per use.

6 If you feel any physical abnormality, discontinue use immediately.

 $\bigcirc$  Stop the operation before using the conductor for another person.

<sup>®</sup> Recommend using the front and back plates alternately.

(9) If you have not used the conductor for a month or more, use it for a short period of time

(5 to 10 minutes) and gradually acclimate yourself to it through repeated use.



# How to apply

Before starting operation, appropriately apply plates ACs and BD to the body using the provided velcro.





Apply plates ACs and BD so as not to come in contact with each other.

Set the plates so that they are on the inside and outside of the wrist, respectively, and tighten the belt to fix the plates.



Set the plates ACs and BD so that they are on the inside and outside of your wrist.



Attach the plate so that it is not on the outside of the velcro. If you wear and use the product in this condition, you may receive an electric shock.

## How to use

# How to operate

#### 1. Turn on the power supply

Turn the power switch on the front of the main unit to the "ON" position.

The timer display will show "----" to indicate that the unit is in standby mode.

# 2. Start operation

When the operation button is pressed, the LED lights up and operation starts. The timer changes to display "000" and starts counting up. During operation, the dot at the lower right end of

the timer display blinks.

Be sure to operate with the plate ACs and the plate BD attached to the body.

## 3. Stop operation

If the operation button is pressed again during operation, the LED turns off and operation is stopped (Operation is suspended). At this time, the timer is not reset and the timer is

displayed as it was when operation was stopped.

#### When resuming operation ••

When the operation button is pressed again, the LED lights up and starts counting up from the time when operation was stopped.









# How to operate

#### Maximum operating time is 60 min

#### **End of operation**

When the maximum operating time is reached, an end tone sounds, the LED turns off, and operation is stopped.

# **Remove the plates ACs and BD**

Please make sure to remove the plug from the main unit, holding down the main unit so that it will not slip out of place.



# Care and storage

#### How to care

- The main body should be wiped dry with a soft cloth, etc. If the surface is heavily soiled, wipe it with a cloth soaked in diluted neutral detergent, and then wipe it thoroughly with a dry cloth.
- Keep the plates ACs and BD apart and let them dry naturally.
- Please wash the velcro and covers frequently as sweat components will adhere to them.



Never use benzine or thinner for cleaning.

When removing cords, do not apply excessive force to the connections, such as by holding the cord and pulling it out.

Before cleaning, hold the AC adapter plug and disconnect it from the outlet as it may cause electric shock.

#### How to store the device

- Keep the body unit and accessories clean, wash covers, etc. and then store them in a dry place in order so that they work properly when used next time.
- Please keep the product away from dust and insects.
- Please remove dust between outlet and AC adapter plug.

## A Storage Precautions

#### Do not store in the following places.

- Please keep the product away from fire or heat source.
- Do not store the products in precarious places.
- Do not expose the product to direct sunlight.
- Please keep the product out of reach of child.

#### How to dispose of or transfer the device

• If you wish to dispose of or transfer the device, contact your dealer for safety and legal reasons.

#### When you use the device after a long period of storage, contact your dealer and have it inspected.

# **Frequently Asked Questions**

Question	Answer
No or low sound from the plates.	The sound coming from a plate is a discharge sound generated when electrons pass through inside space of the plate. It varies depending on various reasons such as the usage environment and deterioration of the plate. The loudness of the sound cannot be used as a criterion for output as it varies depending on the environment.

# MEMO

#### Replacement of consumables (Not covered by warranty)

- The plate is consumable.
- To maintain full performance, it is recommended that plate ACs be replaced every year.
- If you use a broken or damaged plate BD, you may receive an electric shock, so we recommend that you inspect the plate BD every 1 to 2 years.
- When the AC adapter or any of the plates is damaged, discontinue use as it is dangerous to use it continuously. Replace damaged one with new one.
- A plate which has been used for many years may cause burns, electric shock or firedue to cable breakage, etc.

#### **After-Sales Service**

If you find anything wrong with the main unit, please contact your dealer. Before requesting repair, please refer to "If you think something is wrong" on page 16.

If you still find something wrong, stop using the product, unplug the AC adapter, and contact the dealer where you purchased it.
